We are delighted to offer you the opportunity to take part in our 2024 program. Sponsorship plays an essential role in helping Youth Parliament flourish.

The Tasmanian Youth Parliament allows a group of passionate, enthusiastic and diverse young people from around the state to come together to learn about our systems of government. Throughout the week we run educational and social activities to facilitate engagement with the political process. We aim to encourage young people to speak up on the issues that matter to them, and empower them with the knowledge of how to engage meaningfully with communities and lawmakers.

The conference functions as a platform for young Tasmanians to have their voice heard, and to come together discuss key issues facing our state. The Youth Parliament program is run by a team of volunteers, with support from the Y Hobart and with a financial grant from the Department of Premier and Cabinet of the State Government of Tasmania.

However, in recent years, Youth Parliament has faced new challenges, with the COVID-19 pandemic and rising operating costs combining to prevent



the conference from running in 2020 and 2022. In 2023, we bounced back about rebuilt the program despite these challenges. This year, with our highest participant count in five years, we have two key priorities: **financial sustainability** amid rising costs, and **accessibility**, to ensure our program remains affordable for all young Tasmanians, this year and into the future.

This prospectus describes how you can get involved in sponsoring the program, engaging with the enthusiastic and intelligent young people who come from around the state to be involved. Give us the opportunity to offer financial assistance to those participants who need it, making our program inclusive and accessible.

OUR IMPACT

The Tasmanian Youth Parliament provides young people from around our state with the opportunity to advocate for issues that matter to them. We facilitate workshops, speaker panels, advocacy sessions, and debates that help participants develop the skills to participate in civic life. The bills created and debated by participants are presented to the Government at the end of the week as a collection of Youth Proposals.

In 2023, 70% of our participants were from public schools, and 47% from regional areas, with 24% needing a bursary to attend the program. With your help, we can help this program reach even more young people.

OUR SPONSORSHIP PACKAGES

We offer three sponsorship packages. Each package has a scholarship component and a general funding component. The general component will go towards helping us meet the operational costs of Youth Parliament.

The scholarship component of your investment will go into a pool, and be allocated to participants according to the following priorities:

1. Funding **full scholarships** to participants who are in financial need, with a priority for students from **your electorate**.
2. If all participants in financial need are funded, your sponsorship will instead go toward **lowering registration fees** across the board, making YP **more accessible** for everyone!
